

Course Description
Kentucky Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control (KEPSC) Program
Erosion and Sediment Control Introductory Course

Purpose: This course is designed to provide a basic understanding of the KPDES Stormwater Permit requirements for construction sites, and familiarity with the principles of erosion and sediment control.

Who Should Attend: Individuals seeking to qualify to attend the Inspector Qualification Training Course, and individuals who are seeking general knowledge of national and state environmental issues and regulations as they relate to construction and regulations relating to water quality protection will benefit from the course.

Instruction: The six-hour course begins with registration at 8:15 a.m. instruction begins at 8:30 a.m. and adjourns around 3:30 p.m. Topics include Requirements for Construction Site Stormwater Permits, Origin of Permitting Program, and Basic Best Management Practices (BMPs) for Construction Sites, and an overview of other environmental programs that must be included in the preparation of BMP plans. The course provides MS4 programs the opportunity to present local conditions and expectations. Currently, three individuals are qualified as instructors, with each class being taught by one instructor.

Registration and Fee: The fee for the course is \$100 and includes materials and lunch. Payment must be received prior to the class except for Kentucky Transportation Cabinet employees; Cabinet District Employees must register through their District Training Coordinators. Transportation Cabinet Central Office Personnel must have approval from their Division Director and register through the Division of Employee Development. Attendance: To receive a certificate of completion for this course, each participant must be in the classroom promptly at 8:30 and attend the entire 6 hours of training.

Class Size: Participants will be limited to 40 per site; class will be cancelled if less than 15 are enrolled 48 hours in advance of the course. A waitlist will be maintained and additional courses added as needed.

Confirmation/Cancellation: An invoice/receipt will be sent to each participant upon receipt of registration. A confirmation letter and directions will be mailed two weeks prior to the course. If registered and cannot attend, T2 must be notified at least three business days prior to the workshop. If T2 does not receive advance notice, the participant will be charged the entire registration fee. Note that course dates and locations are subject to change. If there are any changes, the registered participant will be contacted immediately so adjustments can be made.

Locations: The class will be held in various locations throughout the state. See the attached registration form for currently scheduled locations.
